General Benjamin N. Bellis, Air Force Systems Program Director, led a contingent of F14/F15 managers to Lewis last week for a briefing on Lewis capabilities and research in the area of advanced aircraft engines.

The group included members of both the Air Force's Aeronautical Systems Division and the Navy Air Systems Command.

The F14/F15 project is aimed at development of two advanced supersonic fighters which will satisfy both Air Force and Navy requirements during the late 1970's. Lewis' new PSL expansion provides one of the few test facilities in the country with the

capability of complete engine testing for the advanced engines necessary for the new aircraft.
