

HAZEY AND MEILANDER RECEIVE INCENTIVE AWARDS

John J. Hazy of Supersonic Tunnels Operation, was awarded \$15 for his suggestion of changing the operation of the O.K. Start light in the 8x6 SWT control room. This light now indicates to the control room when the drive motor personnel are ready for a complete start, eliminating unnecessary phone calls. The exhaust section and coolers of the PSL Shop and Access Bldg., have a protective device against rise in pressure in the exhaust system. The original installation was a rupture disc with a neoprene cover, which usually resulted in complete loss of both when blown out. Erwin "Bud" Meilander, test facilities foreman in PSL Section, suggested and tried the use of a poppet-type valve in place of the rupture disc. The result has been a \$4560.00 per year savings for which Mr. Meilander has been awarded \$140.
